Camping Information

About the RV Park

The only RV park directly on the New Hampshire coast at the mouth of the Hampton River. The park is located south of the main part of Hampton Beach on Route 1A at the Seabrook-Hampton town line. Route 1A can be easily reached from I-95 by either Route 101 or 286. The campground, with 28 sites, is open for reservable stays from Memorial Day weekend through Columbus Day weekend.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

A park store is located in the day-use area. Restaurants, entertainment, and other services are offered at the Hampton Seashell, located a short walk north.

Activities

The park is close to many area attractions, including whale watching, saltwater fishing charter boats, sandy beaches, and swimming.

For Your Safety

The RV park is located in an urban area. Please keep valuables secured inside your vehicle when not in use.

Reservations may be made by calling ReserveAmerica at 1-877-nhparks (1-877-647-2757), or online at www.nhstateparks.org. Reservations for organized youth group camping are required and should be made by calling the Concord Office at (603) 271-3556.

About the Policies

- Reservations may be made for a maximum of 14 nights from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend.
- Campers with a reservation must register at the campground office upon arrival and must arrive by 8 pm. The reservation confirmation letter and a valid driver's license is needed when registering.
- Check-in time is between 1 pm and 8 pm. Check-out time is 11 am.
- Payment due upon registration may be made by cash, voucher, money order, Mastercard, Visa, or Discover.
- You must be able to hook up to water, sewer, and electricity.
- Tents, auxiliary shelters, and pop-ups are not permitted.
- Pets are not permitted in the park or at the beach. Pets are not permitted in the RV campground from April 1st through September 15th.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and are welcome during posted visitor hours. They must park in the day-use area.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Alcohol is not permitted outside your vehicle.
- Trash and recycling receptacles are located by the office.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. Please do not bring firewood from out-of-state locations.

Thank you for choosing to visit New Hampshire State Parks. Fees received go directly back into the operation of the park system.
